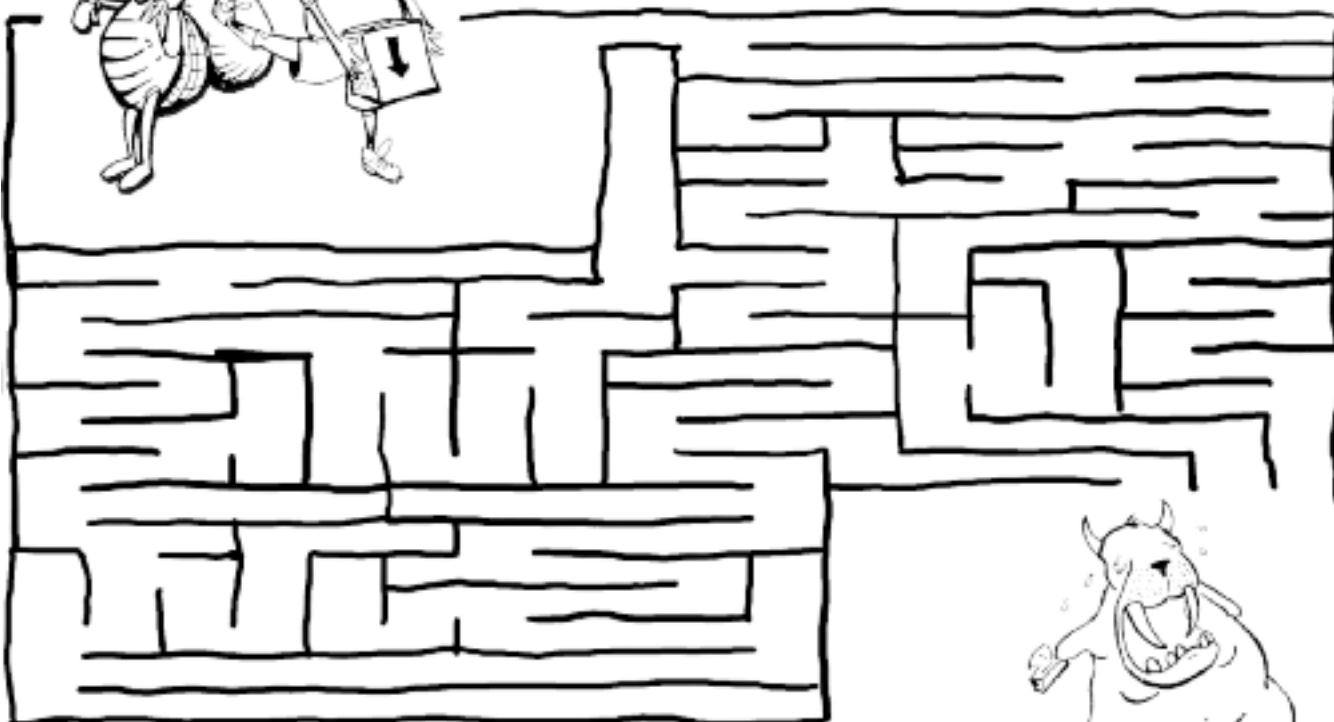

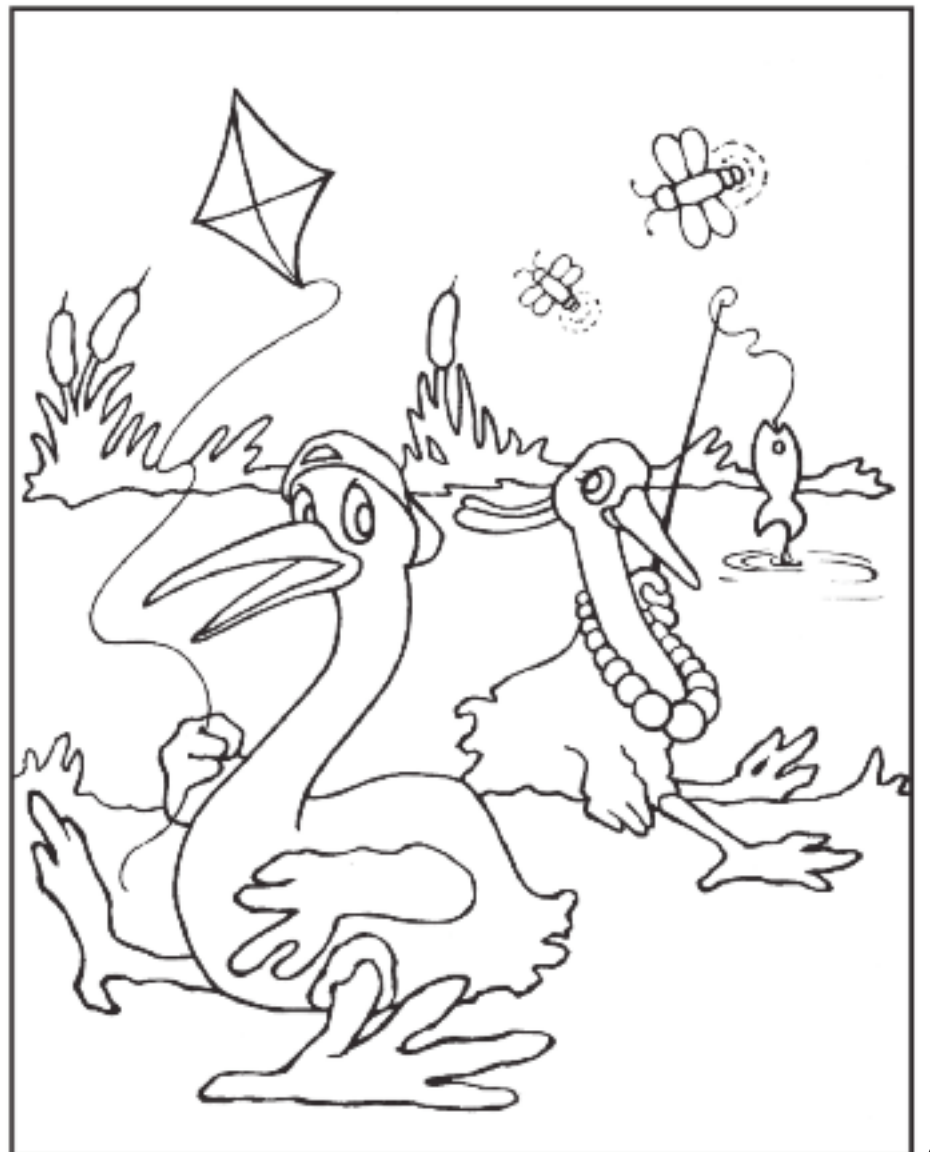
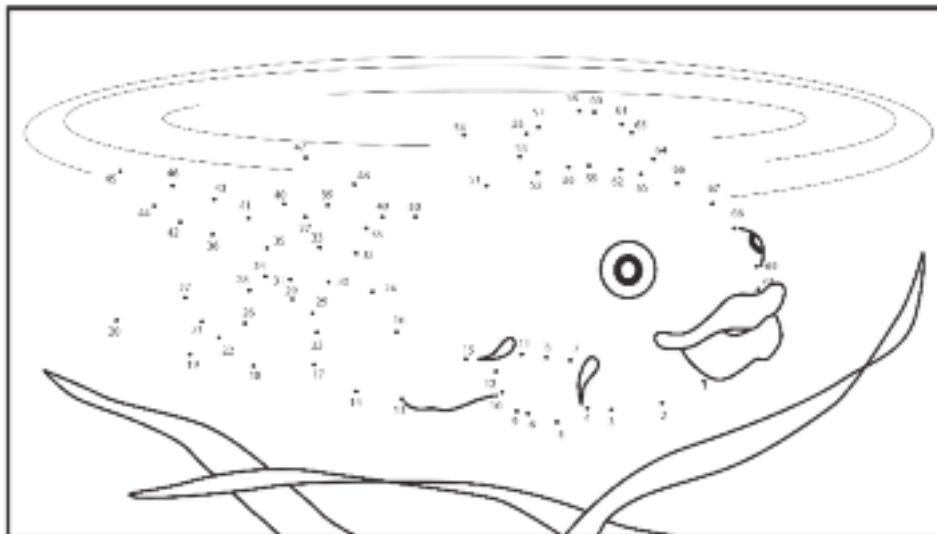

Heron & Crane is based on a classic Russian folk-tale. Russia is the biggest country in the world, so lots and lots of people speak the Russian language! You can use this guide to start learning some simple Russian words and phrases. (Practice with your friends!)

Russian uses a different alphabet called Cyrillic. This chart helps you to pronounce the Russian word using the same letters that we use in English and then shows you how the word looks in its original Cyrillic!

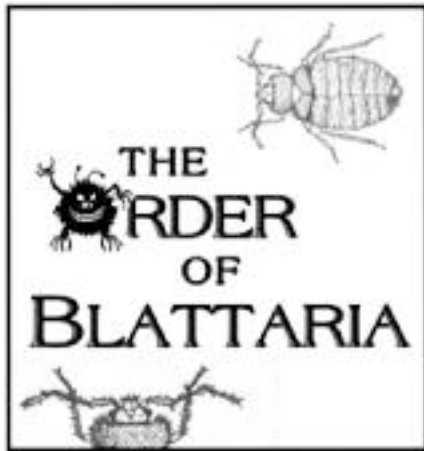
